New Growth Comes From Deep Roots

Acorn School is embracing the adaptations needed to make the 2020-2021 school year spectacular. It is amazing to see how these necessary changes are sprouting new growth, while we also honor Acorn's roots and traditions.

Our treasured Acorn School Street sign, with its season-themed flag blowing in the wind, is a deep root in in our community. It is the visual school symbol that caregivers and teachers look for as we drive down beautiful Winnicutt Road.

In the mid 80's this sign was was designed by an Acorn parent, Abigail Phillips from Exeter, who has since died of cancer. She designed it with her daughter, her daughter's three carpool friends, and her daughter's new "crush" at school.

Part of Acorn School's evolution includes the installation of our new driveway sign, which was donated to the school as a gift. It includes our school logo which helps with visual recognition, our contact information, and provides opportunities for increased street visibility.

Acorn School's original sign has found a cozy home on our "Wheel House" shed, nestled in the carpool loop. This shed is also a new addition to our grounds, and shelters Acorn School's bikes.

Abigail's sign will now welcome families and teachers for years to come, right where her inspiration was sparked: her family's carpool crew. Her sign will remain a part of Acorn School's history, and our new growth.




